Mitacs-USask Globalink Research Award Co-Funding Program

This is a preliminary application to the Mitacs Globalink Research Award (GRA) co-funding programs offered at the University of Saskatchewan, to be completed by a USask faculty member. The purpose is to ensure eligibility and assist in allocating a limited number of GRA awards. Due to the limited availability of seven (7) co-funding internships allowed by Mitacs for 2024-25, each faculty member is restricted to nominating a maximum of two (2) students. If the two students come from different universities, please provide information in separate forms. If approved, the student or post-doctoral fellow (PDF) (with the assistance of the home and host supervisors) will be invited to complete the Mitacs application. Please submit this preliminary application to the International Office, international.office@usask.ca, by **August 20, 2024**. Approved applicants will be directed to submit the full application via UnivRS for institutional signature to submit to Mitacs.

Travel to Canada or from Canada can be supported. Successful student applicants notified by Mitacs have up to 12 months to execute their 12-24 week research abroad projects, which may include up to 25% time spent at the home institution.
