

University of Saskatchewan Faculty Intention to Apply (2025-2026)

Mitacs-USask Globalink Research Award Allocation Program

This is a preliminary application to the Mitacs Globalink Research Award (GRA) allocation program offered at the University of Saskatchewan, to be completed by a USask faculty member. The purpose is to ensure eligibility and assist in allocating a limited number of GRA awards. Due to the limited availability of ten(10) internship units allowed by Mitacs for 2025-26, each faculty member is restricted to apply for a maximum of two (2) internship units. Each internship unit provides \$6000 for an internship duration of 12 – 24 weeks. Thus, one student can undertake one 12 to 24-week project (one IU) or two 12 to 48-week projects (two IUs) with a host supervisor. If approved, the student or post-doctoral fellow (PDF) (with the assistance of the home and host supervisors) will be invited to complete the Mitacs application. Please submit this preliminary application to the International Office, international.office@usask.ca, by **June 30, 2025**. Applications will be reviewed on a first come, first served basis. Approved applicants will be directed to submit the full application via UnivRS for institutional signature to submit to Mitacs.

Travel to Canada or from Canada can be supported. Successful student applicants notified by Mitacs have up to 12 months to execute their 12-48 week research abroad projects, which may include up to 25% time spent at the home institution.
