

## University of Saskatchewan Faculty Intention to Apply Mitacs-USask Globalink Research Award Co-Funding Program

This is a preliminary application to the Mitacs Globalink Research Award (GRA) co-funding programs offered at the University of Saskatchewan, to be completed by a USask faculty member. The purpose is to ensure eligibility and assist in allocating a limited number of GRA awards. This is not the student application for the GRA. If approved, the student or post-doctoral fellow (PDF) (with the assistance of the home and host supervisors) will be invited to complete the Mitacs application. Please submit this preliminary application to the International Office, [international.office@usask.ca](mailto:international.office@usask.ca), by **February 9, 2024**. If successful, please submit the full application through **UnivRS** by **March 22, 2024** for institutional signature to submit to Mitacs via its new online portal by March 31, 2024. Travel to Canada or from Canada can be supported, and successful student applicants notified by Mitacs have up to 12 months to execute their 12-24 week research abroad projects, which may include up to 25% time spent at the home institution.
